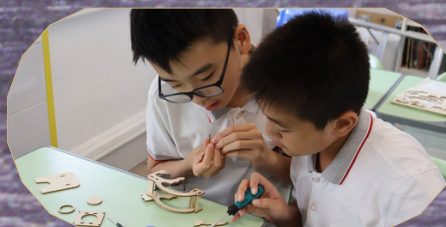
Teacher Appreciation

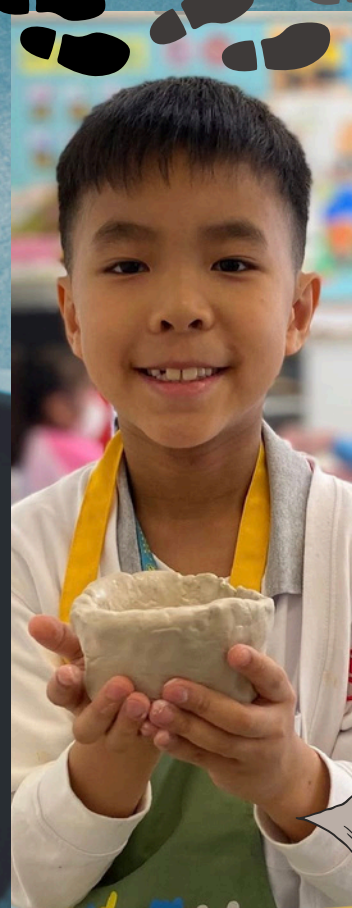
