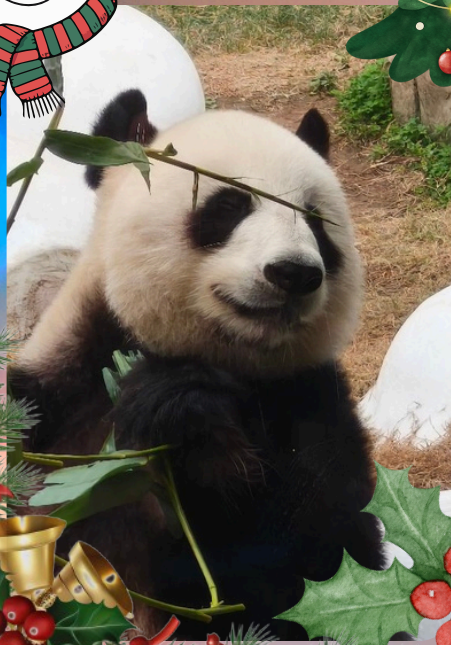
Ocean Park
