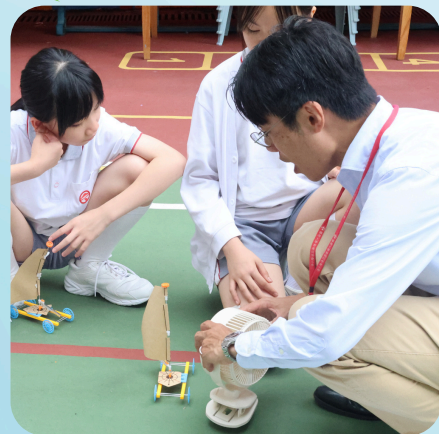


Newsletter
